Point to Point/Uplink Details:

a link seems infeasible (David). Recommend 2.4GHz 11g link on channel 2, 9, or 11. Mount point on SE corner Brick/Adobe facade (see [1] in figure).

WiLAN Coverage Details:

One or two WiFi networks for them, plus link back to Urban15. This will require three to four WRT54G units total (see site survey). Their main WiLAN needs to be a closed, registered MAC/WEP network, with documentation to tell them how to add new machines.
